+ Gold Standard Care

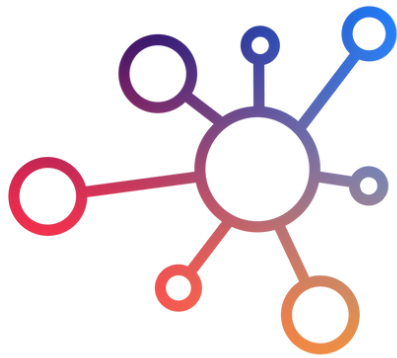
To establish a US standard for best practice of comprehensive, multi-disciplinary care, and to increase access to these necessary services for patients with MSA.

To support Mission MSA in its mission to improve quality of life and bring hope to those affected by MSA through enhanced care, support, community, education, and research.

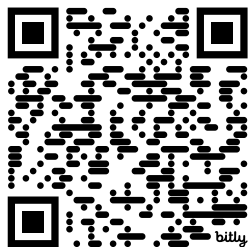
