

WHAT ARE THE MSA CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE?

CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE OBJECTIVES

- +Minimum of 10 established patients
- +1/2 day per month of MSA clinic time
- +Option for telemedicine visits
- +MSA experienced neurologist
- +Designated multi-disciplinary team available on site or for referral
- +Access to specialty testing
- +Access to MSA clinical trials
- +Ability to provide care to those without insurance or unable to pay
- +Access to MSA support groups
- +Ability to provide professional education to aid in clinical diagnosis, support, and improve quality of care
- +Ability to collaborate with Mission MSA and affiliated MSA COE sites on programs, patient support and education, and advocacy initiatives.

MSA Centers of Excellence (COEs) provide comprehensive multi-disciplinary clinical and support services for MSA patients, care partners, and families. These services will be centered around an established MSA clinic in which an individual's care needs have been defined, and a plan has been created by their team to fulfill those needs.

Due to the rare nature of this disease and the complexity of its symptoms, many MSA patients see a multitude of providers before receiving their diagnosis. It is imperative that the MSA COEs provide timely, exemplary, and informative medical care from their muti-disciplinary team to MSA patients, their care partners, and those impacted by MSA.
